

Kate is 26 years old. She is just starting out on her own. She wants a car that works for where she lives and the lifestyle she leads.






THIS IS WHERE KATE LIVES





Commercial flashes to the bride, in the car, yelling at her driver to hurry up and find parking as she answers her phone.


